Planned Parenthood of Kansas and Mid-Missouri accepts Commercial Insurance as well as Kansas and Missouri Medicaid plans. Please see the list of insurance plans below to find out which ones include Planned Parenthood as an in-network provider.

If you are uninsured, you may qualify for a state funded program or a lower fee scale. Please bring the following documents with you to your appointment:

- Birth certificate
- Pay stub
- Photo ID

We accept Cash, Check, or Major Credit/Debit Cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover) Payment is expected at the time of service. Payment plans may be available for many services.

INSURANCE INFORMATION

Most health insurance plans now cover prescription birth control, annual wellness exams, and HIV and STI screenings with no copay, and many other services with some copay required. You should contact your health insurance company directly to confirm that the services you are interested in are covered, and what, if any, out-of-pocket costs you are required to pay.
