



Equal Visitation Policy

Planned Parenthood of Southwest and Central Florida (PPSWCF) promotes patient and family-centered care while providing a therapeutic environment for patients and a safe environment for patients, family, visitors, and staff.

In accordance with PPSWCF's non-discrimination policy and patient bill of rights, patients have the right to a support person(s) of their choice, including but not limited to, a spouse, child, parent, family member, friend, domestic partner, and significant other.

PPSWCF does not restrict, limit, or otherwise deny visitation rights on the basis of race, color, ethnicity, national origin, age, size, disability, religion, culture, language, socioeconomic status, military service, marital status, pregnancy status, income, citizenship, status with regard to public assistance, sex assigned at birth, sexual orientation, and gender identity or expression.

Visitation may be clinically restricted or limited in certain circumstances. Ask a staff member for more information.
