





PATIENT INCOME





Supporting Survivors of Sexual Assault

PPNCNY's Sexual Assault Services (SAS) and staff serves Clinton, Franklin and Essex counties. We provide on and off site visits with clients, school-based visits, courthouse accompaniments, legal advocacy and Office of Victim Services (OVS) compensation claim assistance. We also provide a 24-hour Sexual Assault Hotline and counseling to victims of sexual violence and their families.
