Sex Ed Boot Camp (SEBC) is a dynamic and engaging virtual conference that brings together experts across the field to provide participants with relevant information on teaching sexuality education to young people. This conference aims to increase the network of trusted adults who are prepared and available to answer questions related to sexual health for youth in our communities.



The expansion signifies our unwavering commitment to protecting and expanding access to abortion care by increasing the number of procedure rooms and adding a patient recovery room.

PPSO plays a vital role in the future of abortion nationally and remains at the forefront, fighting for the rights of individuals to access safe and legal abortion care. The Medford remodel and expansion is part of a much larger, national picture for abortion and reproductive healthcare access for all.

As folks across the country continue to navigate the abortion landscape, PPSO is grateful for the investments of our donors that ensure we are able to expand safe and convenient abortion care to our patients.



PPSO's Southern Oregon Health Centers already serve as access points for a broad scope of reproductive health services for those living in Southern Oregon, and those traveling from Eastern Oregon and Northern California. This expansion allows PPSO to better serve folks in the area that are often forced to endure delays to care due to travel.

THIS SUMMER, OREGON'S GOVERNOR Tina Kotek made history by signing HB2002 into law!

HB2002 is a first-of-its-kind bill which protects patients and providers following the fall of Roe and will address gaps in access for those who need it most.

HB2002 ensures:

- New protections are in place for all providers in Oregon, effectively solidifying legal protections and preventing our providers from being subpoenaed and prosecuted outof-state for providing abortion and gender affirming care services.
- Out-of-pocket costs for gender-affirming care are covered by insurance companies.

This is a big win in our fight for reproductive rights for Oregonians and a huge step toward expanding access to care for all.

We remain committed to a world where access to health care, including sexual and reproductive care, is a human right for everyone – no matter their income, their immigration status, or their gender identity. No Matter What.
