# **Middle School**

Workshops are 45-60 min, each with a student to facilitator ratio of no more than 25:1.

Package A is \$1,200 and Package B is \$600.

## Package A: Six Sessions

#### Reproductive Anatomy

Internal and external organs and how they work. Processes such as menstruation, ovulation, and ejaculation explained.

#### Puberty & Hygiene

The physical, emotional, and social changes that occur as people mature. Trans-inclusive.

#### LGBTQ+ Inclusivity

Difference between sex, gender, identity, expression, and attraction. Allyship & resources.

# Relationships & Consent

Characteristics of supportive relationships, respecting boundaries, teen dating violence

# Self-Esteem & Body Image

Exercises to practice self-love and self-care. Exploring the -isms that may affect self-esteem.

#### Safer Sex

Understanding potential outcomes of sex (STIs and pregnancy) and how to prevent them
