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Have Insurance?

If You Use Medi-Cal

You can come to Planned Parenthood for most of the care we provide regardless of which insurance plan you choose.

If You Get Your Insurance Through Covered California or an Employer

Your insurance plan gets to choose the doctors you are allowed to see and the services that are covered. If you want to come to Planned Parenthood for routine care like birth control, breast and cervical cancer screenings, and STD testing and treatment, choose an insurance plan that includes Planned Parenthood.

Keep in mind that many insurance plans require you to pay a part of your visit costs (as a co-pay or deductible) at the time you receive services.

Family PACT is Still Here

If you don't have any insurance coverage right now, you may be able to receive no-cost, immediate reproductive health services under California's Family PACT program, depending on your income. Ask us if you qualify.



You May Qualify

In California, there are health insurance options available for people without insurance. These options cover care for doctor visits, hospital costs, prescription drugs and other services. Insurance may be low- or no-cost to you. And you can still come to Planned Parenthood!
