


# How to use depo-subQ provera 104

#### **Getting ready**

- The medicine should be at room temperature, not too cold or too hot.
- Do not put it in the refrigerator or freezer.
- The medicine should be white in color, with no particles floating inside.
- You should have 3 things in front of you:




# **Step 1: Choose & prepare the injection area**

#### Choose the injection area.

- Avoid bony areas and the navel (belly button).
- The upper thigh and abdomen (belly) are the best places to give the shot. See shaded areas in the picture.

Use an alcohol pad to wipe the skin in the injection area you chose.

Let the skin dry.

### **Step 2: Prepare the syringe**

Carefully remove the needle and syringe from the packaging.

Hold the syringe firmly by the barrel, with the barrel pointing up.


• Shake it hard for at least 1 minute to mix the medicine well.

Hold the syringe barrel firmly.

• Remove the protective cap from the tip of the syringe barrel.


- Attach the needle to the barrel of the syringe by pushing down hard with a small twist.
- Move the safety shield away from the needle and toward the syringe barrel. The safety shield will stay in an open position (as shown in the picture).
- While holding the syringe barrel firmly, remove
  the plastic needle cover from the needle without
  twisting, making sure the needle is still firmly
  attached to the syringe.
- While holding the syringe with the needle pointing up, slowly and gently push in the plunger until the medicine is up to the top of the syringe. There should be no air in the barrel.






# Step 3: Inject the shot

**Gently grasp and squeeze the area of skin** you chose for your shot (thigh or belly). Hold the skin between the thumb and forefinger, pulling it away from the body.




Insert the needle at a 45 degree angle (like in the picture) so that most of the needle is in the fatty tissue.

 The plastic hub of the needle should be nearly or almost touching the skin.



**Inject the medicine** slowly until the syringe is empty.

- It is important that you use all of the medicine in the syringe.
- This should take about 5-7 seconds.




# Step 4: Dispose the needle and syringe


After you're done, take the needle out of your skin.

Put the safety shield back on by pushing it against a flat surface, toward the needle. The shield is in place when you hear or feel a click.

If uncertain that the safety shield is fully engaged, repeat this step.



- Do NOT rub the area.
- Apply an adhesive bandage, if needed.






After each dose is given, the used syringe should be discarded in a safe and proper manner. Keep away from children.

# WHAT TO DO WITH USED SHARPS IN PENNSYLVANIA Put used sharps in a strong, plastic container.



#### Put the plastic container in the household trash - don't recycle!



#### Sharps should never by thrown loosely into the trash or toilet.

Sharps that retract after use, or are very small, should be disposed of like all other sharps.
