HOW TO TALK ABOUT ABORTION

- Abortion is health care, a small but important part of what Planned Parenthood does
- No one does more to prevent unintended pregnancies than Planned Parenthood with their birth control services and sexual education programs
- Planned Parenthood provides people with all of their options, including parenting, adoption, and abortion, and trusts them to make the best decision for their needs
- According to the Turnaway Study, people who are denied an abortion are four times more likely to live below the federal poverty level and are more likely to experience generational poverty

- Abortion is a deeply personal and sometimes complex decision and should be made by the individual with the counsel of their health care provider, not politicians
- The stigma around abortion keeps people silent and can be harmful because it makes individuals feel alone in their experience and makes it easier to restrict access


HELPFUL FACTS



1 in 5 women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center at least once in her life.



Nationally, Planned Parenthood serves over 2 million people each year and educated over 500,000 people with honest, accurate sexual health information.





By age 45, half of American women will have an unintended pregnancy and nearly 1 in 4 will have an abortion.



The majority of Americans support a woman's right to safe and legal abortion.



OTHER HOT TOPICS

Government Funding

- Federal Funds are not used for abortion.
 The Hyde Amendment, passed by Congress in 1976, bans the use of federal funds to pay for abortions, with exceptions for the life of the woman is in danger, or when the pregnancy results from rape or incest
- Rigorous research shows that the preventative health care Planned Parenthood provides saves taxpayer money in the long run
- "Defunding" Planned Parenthood by not allowing them to get reimbursed through the Medi-Cal program would take away essential health care services and education from more than 250,000 people living in Orange and San Bernardino counties

Politics

- Planned Parenthood believes all people no matter where they live - should have the right to control their own body, life, and future, not politicians
- Reproductive health has historically been a bi-partisan issue. Leading Republicans legalized abortion in California (Reagan), started the Title X federal family planning grant (Nixon), and abolished abstinence-only sex education and started California's subsidized family planning program (Wilson)

When Life Begins

 Questions about when life begins are personal and complex. For some it's based on faith; for others, it's a matter of science

Labels Like "Pro-Choice" & "Pro-Life"

 "Pro-choice" and "pro-life" labels don't reflect the complexity of how most people actually think and feel about abortion. Instead of putting people in one category or another, we should respect the real-life decisions people and their families face every day

BIG PICTURE TIPS

DO speak with a confident, nonjudgmental voice Avoid sounding strident or defensive

DO lead with our wide range of preventive health services

DO explain that we are a not-for-profit

DO share how many people rely on Planned Parenthood

DO talk about health information, prevention, and education

DO emphasize that we provide confidential, compassionate care to everyone, regardless of their personal situation or ability to pay

DO share real stories to reduce abortion stigma When talking about abortion, use phrases like "ending a pregnancy," "abortion," and the need

for a "safe and legal procedure"
